Married at St Lukes, Old Street, Finsbury, London. "William Meredith of the Parish of St John, Hackney, Batchelor and Penninah Cadman of this Parish Spinster were married in this Church (St Lukes, Old Street, Finsbury) by License this 6th Day of September 1784. In the presence of John Cadman & Mary Cadman and Thomas Meredith" [1] Their ages are given as 39 and 30 'upwards' on the marriage licence

All children baptised at St Ethelburga Bishops Gate, London [2]

William is in the Griffiths Valuation of 1853 at East Beach Queenstown

William joined the Royal Navy and was promoted to Paymaster. He was sent to Queenstown and served on the flagship of Sir Benjamin Hallowell Carew [1]
